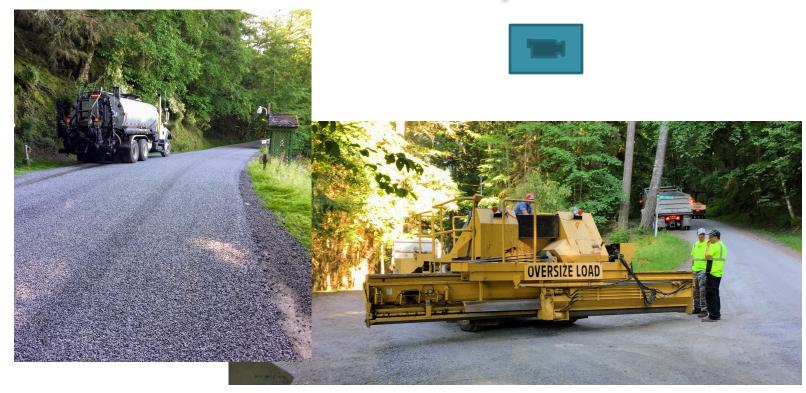
Annual Meeting Structure

 - Members only for voting on routine issues signed RMA
